Classes, entry fees and additional information

H21(3 legs): €90 / team

D21(3 legs): €90 / team

HD 16 (3 legs): €50 / team, there must be at least 1 girl in the team

Classes H21 and D21 are classes of the Orienteering Relay League and HD16 is a competition of the youth relay league.

Open Class Orienteering 5 and 3 km: €10

Open class orientators will enter the terrain after the starts of the HD16 and D21 classes.

Terrain

A continuous forest area in Vuokatinvaara, crossed by a single forest road. The terrain has a maximum height difference of 90 meters. Orienteering happened in this terrain at the 2025 Kainuu Orienteering Week.

Map

Printed map 5/2025, updates 5/2026 in plastic cover. The scale of the longer course is 1:10 000 and the shorter course is 1:7 500. Contour interval 5 m. Map size is A4.

Registration

Registration is open until Monday 22nd of June at 11:59 p.m. on The Finnish Orienteering Federation's IRMA service. The registration fee is paid with the registration in IRMA.

Late registration for the relay with double the participation fee using The Finnish Orienteering Federation's IRMA service or by email, harri.hakkarainen@vuokattisport.fi. Late registrations must be received no later than Thursday 25th of June 2026 at 11:59 p.m.

Open class participants can register in advance in the Rastilippu service. You can also register at the competition venue at the information desk at the same price €10. In this case, the registration fee is paid on site at the information desk with cash, card payment or MobilePay.

Running orders

The running orders and emit numbers of the relay teams must be submitted to the IRMA service by Friday 26th of June at 6:00 p.m. Any changes to the running order and emit numbers after this are subject to a fee and must be submitted to the information desk by 9 a.m. on the day of the race at the latest. The change fee (5 € / change) is paid to the information desk.

Tracking

All legs of the men's and women's relay will have GPS tracking. If the team which is selected for GPS tracking refuses to carry the tracking device will be disqualified from the competition.

Punching system

Emit punching. For the relay, the number of rented emits must be reported per team. The rental fee of 5 euros is paid to the information desk. We will charge 70 euros for unreturned emits. Competing with the wrong emit card will result in disqualification. The competitor is responsible for the functionality of their emit card.



Arrival

You must arrive to the competition venue via official guidance. Guidance starts from VT6 at the Rekivaarantie intersection, from where it is approximately 15 minutes to the competition centre. The navigation address to the start of the guidance is Rekivaarantie 35 (Sotkamo). Guidance will be in place from 12:00 noon on the competition day.

Parking is arranged as roadside parking along Rekivaarantie. In good weather, also partly as field parking at the competition centre. We are testing the Eventilla system for parking for the Jukola relay. If you register for parking in advance, there is no parking fee. More detailed instructions on the competition website. Otherwise, the parking fee is 10 euros per car. Parking tickets can be purchased at the information desk. Payment methods include cash, card payments and MobilePay. The paid parking fee must be presented when leaving the parking area.

Services at the competition centre

- Competition café, where light snacks and drinks are available. Payment methods include cash, card payments and MobilePay.
- Toilets (Bajamajas)
- There is no washing area on site. Washing is available at Vuokatti Sport.
