Accidents:

Contact the first aid point at the arena phone +358 400 467 219

- 1. Explain what has happened
- 2. Prevent further accidents
- 3. Check the patient's condition
- 4. Check the breathing
- 5. Move the patient to the correct position
- 6. Danger of death call 112
- 7. Arrange guidance to the location

Danger of death or serious accidents call 112

Emergency phone call to 112:

1. CALL 112 YOURSELF IF YOU HAVE THE POSSIBILITY.

It is important that the call is made by the person at the accident because the person has information that the first aid needs.

2. EXPLAIN WHAT HAPPENED.

So that they can send the right help.

3. EXPLAIN THE EXACT LOCATION OF THE EMERGENCY.

There might be similar places with the same address so it is important to tell the exact location of where you are.

4. ANSWERE ALL THE QUESTIONS.

- 5. DO AS YOU ARE TOLD AND FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS YOU GET BY THE FIRST AID.
- 6. DONT END THE CALL UNTILL YOU GET PERMISSION TO DO SO.

- Guide all help to the location
- Call 112 again if the situation is changed
